



Nurturing your Newborn While this can be an enjoyable and rewarding time, at some point, most new mothers find themselves asking the questions of "when, where and how much" to feed baby. The answer to all these questions is generally "whenever baby wants feeding." A well-fed baby is a content baby. And it's important to realize that every baby maintains a different feeding schedule.

Breast-fed newborns often nurse 8-12 times in a twenty-four hour period and each feeding lasts between 15-45 minutes. To know if your baby is feeding well, look to the number of diapers you change. By the end of the first week, your baby should have 6-8 wet and 3-5 bowel movements in a 24-hour period. Bottle-fed babies tend to feed every 2-3 hours, consuming 45 ml.-125 ml. at each feeding. As your baby develops, you'll find that he'll consume more at each feeding, resulting in fewer feedings throughout a 24-hour period and shorter feeding times.

Whatever method you choose, look to your baby for cues. In his own unique way, he will indicate when he's hungry and when he is satisfied. At each stage of his development, periodic visits to your pediatrician or family doctor, are also recommended. This way, you'll always be aware of your baby's nutritional intake.

Breastfeeding Basics

Some mothers find it can take several days or even several weeks to master the art of breastfeeding. Pillows can be a helpful tool in the early weeks to keep your back and arms well supported during feedings. Remember to hold your baby close and you will both be able to enjoy the enormous benefits of breastfeeding.

Newborn babies learn to breastfeed well with lots of opportunity to practice. Frequent feeding also helps your milk supply increase. You can try different positions to see which work best for you and your baby. Whether using a cradle hold (as on page 120) or a clutch hold with your baby tucked under your arm, it is important to hold your baby very closely against your body.

A good latch during breastfeeding can prevent nipple soreness. It will also reduce the possibility of baby becoming frustrated and falling off the breast. Help your baby get a good latch by supporting the breast with one hand and tickling the baby's lip lightly with the nipple so that the baby opens his mouth wide and takes in not just the nipple but enough of the breast to fill his mouth and ensure that the nipple is at the back of his tongue. The baby may suck with quick, short sucks at first but should soon suck rhythmically and more slowly as he swallows mouthfuls of milk.




Express Yourself

A breast pump might be useful when breastfeeding because it allows Mom to express and store milk for later use, and it can help relieve discomfort from engorgement. A breast pump is a good idea for "just in case" and for working mothers. By pumping and then storing the milk in the refrigerator (max. 8 days) or in a self-contained freezer unit of a refrigerator (for 4 months), you're covered if you ever need to be away at feeding time.

Breastfeeding Benefits

- 1. Breastmilk is natural and full of nutrients and antibodies that protect your baby from most infections and allergies.
- 2. It's all your baby needs for the first 6 months and the benefits can last a lifetime.
- 3. It's a way to connect with baby both physically and emotionally as soon as the baby is born.
- 4. It's free, convenient, always at the right temperature and is most suited to the baby's digestive system.
- 5. Breastfeeding helps mom lose the pregnancy pounds as it tends to "burn off" extra fat and helps the womb contract back to its normal size.
