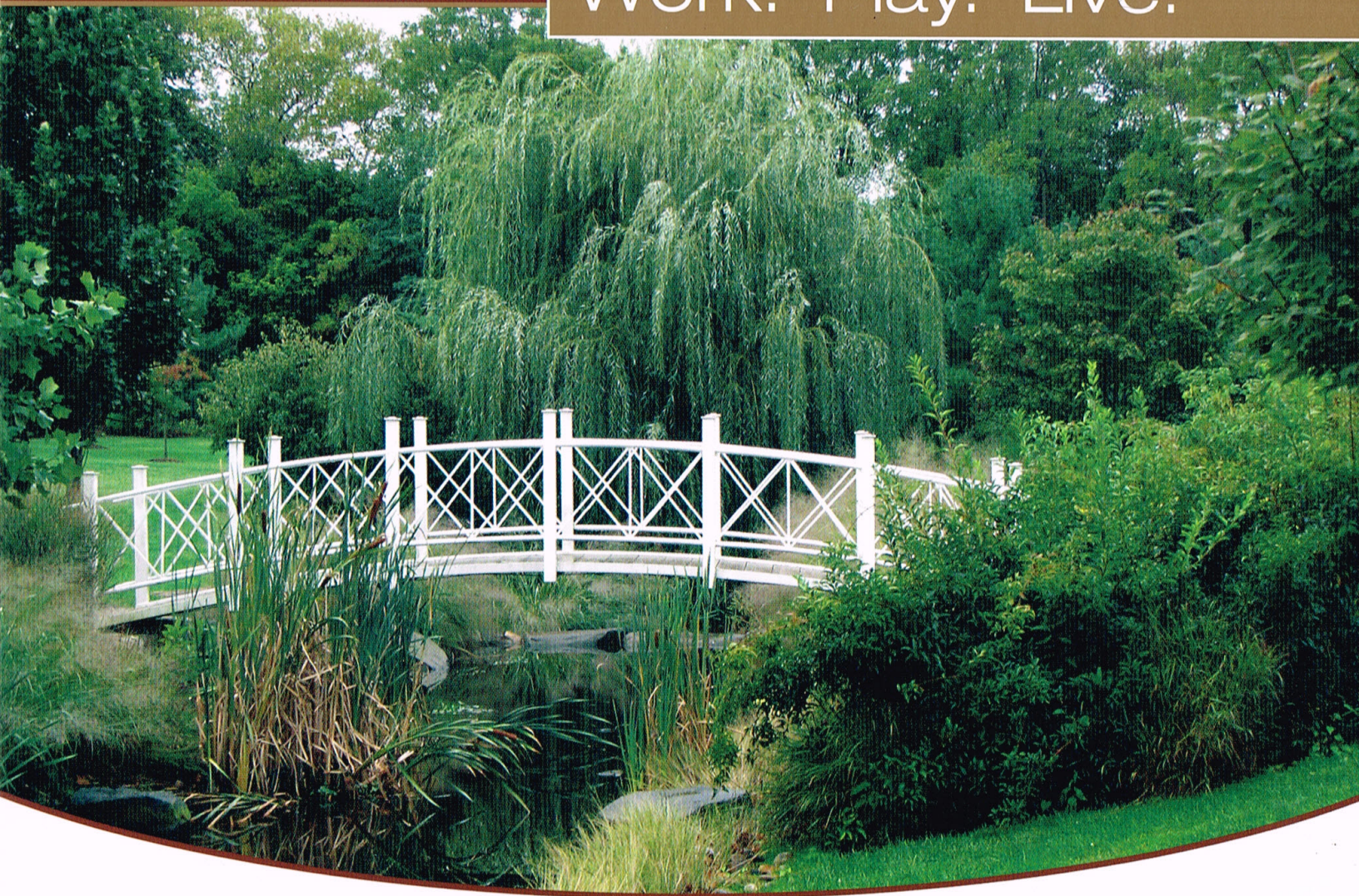

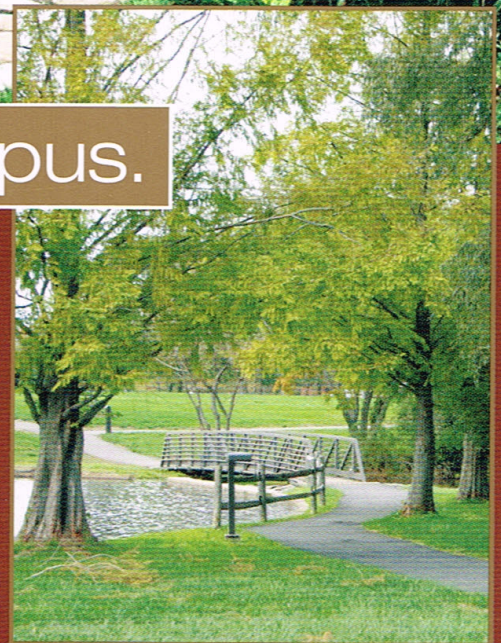




## ETS — Our Princeton Campus.

The ETS campus encompasses 370 wooded acres just minutes from downtown Princeton, a university town where art, culture and community connect.

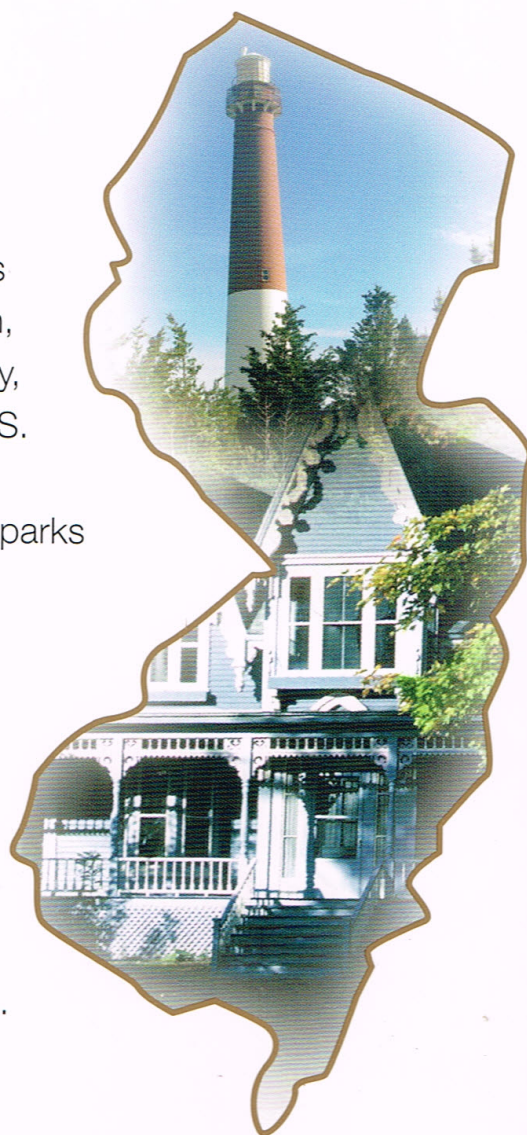




# New Jersey has something

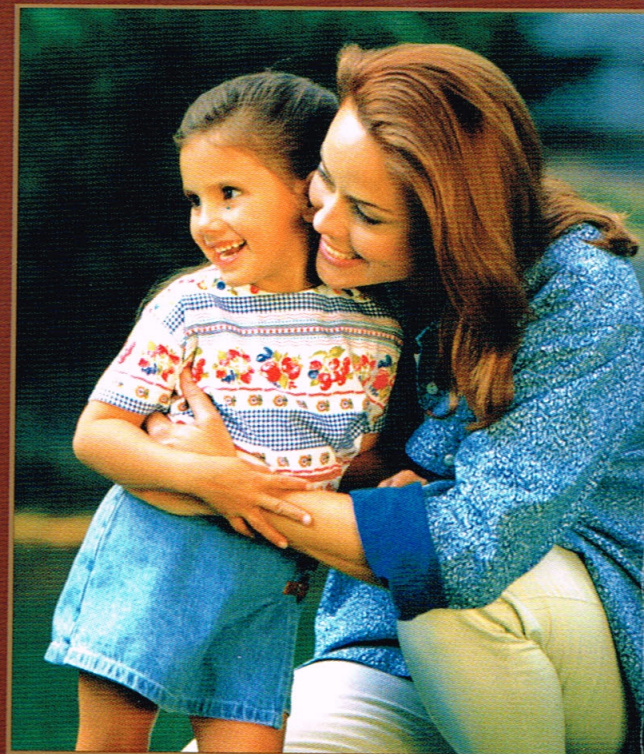
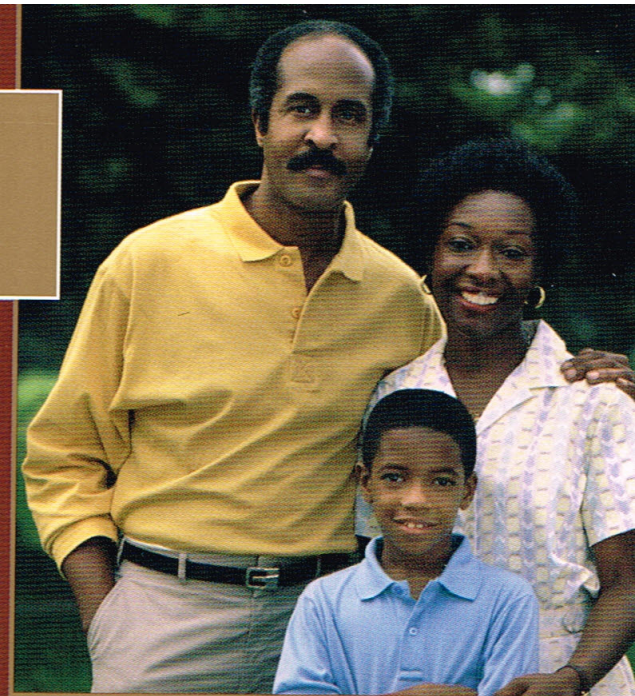
